STREET GRADE RESOLUTION. By Ald. Clancy:

Whereas, in the opinion of the Council the grade on East Ann street ought to be changed and fixed and estab-

lished, to the end that such street may be made suitable for public travel and traffic. Therefore

Resolved, That it is hereby ordered that the grade on East Ann street, from east line of Ingalls street to the center line of Thirteenth street, be, and the same is hereby changed from the present grade and fixed and established, so that the grade on and along such street shall be as follows, that is to say:

At the east line of Ingalls street, 873.00.

At 200 feet east of the center of Ingalls street, 870.50.

At 300 feet east of the center of Ingalls street, 867.00.

At 600 feet east of the center of Ingalls street. 850.50.

At 680 feet east of the center of Ingalls street, 848.50.

At the center of Thirteenth street, 847.77.

The elevation given above being the official city datum and along the center line of said street, and the grade lines to consist of straight lines between the several points or stations above stated, the roadway to conform thereto, and that \$100 be and the same is hereby appropriated for the work.
