Ald. G. Lutz presented bills of Frank J. Wilkinson and James Dowd for services Nov. 7 and 14, 1914, with police department, amount each \$20.00, and moved that bills be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for same, which was adopted by unanimous vote of those present, 13.

The finance and sewers committees, to whom the matter of storm water on Glenn ave. was referred, recommended that city engineer prepare plans, specifications and estimates of cost of storm water sewer from the river to Huron st. and present the same to sewer committee.
