This will advise you that the State Highway Department approves of your awarding the contract for the work on Beakes Street to the Ann Arbor Construction Company, low bidder on the project for inch and a half inch and a half sheet asphalt on seven inch concrete base, the State's share amounting to \$9,724.80, including the cost of cement.

Kindly advise Mr. Lavers, Division Engineer at Plymouth, when you are ready to start the work so the proper arrangements can be made for inspection.

This is your authority to proceed with the work.

In drawing up the contracts, it is suggested that you enter into a contract with the Ann Arbor Construction Company for the entire project including the State's share. This department will authorize the City to do the work involved in the State's portion by formal authorization which will be forthcoming within a few days. We will reimburse the City for the money paid the Ann Arbor Construction Company on regular estimates in favor of the City.
