PETITIONS AND RESOLUTIONS.

The resolution from the Board embodying the corrected estimate of the pavement in Dist. No. 3; the agreement between Contractor Clancy and the Telephone Co.; the recommendation for the allowance of the corrected estimate of \$11,653.67 for paving Dist. No. 3, read and ordered filed.

Ald. Richards moved that Mr. Clancy be allowed \$10,000.00 on the submitted estimate.

Ald. Brown moved an amendment that the Council pay Mr. Clancy the amount due him according to the corrected estimate of \$11,653.67.

ENGINEER'S CORRECTED ESTIMATE.

Ann Arbor, Mich., Oct. 23, '99.

To the Board of Public Works:

Gentlemen—In submitting a corrected estimate of the cost of the pavement in Pavement Dist. No. 3, on Washington st. I offer the following explanation: Main st. intersection is not in the district and in putting down the measurement for the purpose of subtraction I inadvertently added the same which caused the error in the number of sq. yards of pavement.

Ald. Vandawarker submitted the necessary sidewalk grade resolution for establishing the grade on the east side of Observatory st. which was adopted.

Ald. Coon submitted the necessary Street Grade Resolution for establishing the grade on Observatory st. which was adopted.

Resolved, That it is the purpose of the Common Council of the City of Ann Arbor to cause Huron street to be paved during the coming season, the cost thereof to be assessed against the abutting property, street crossings excepted.

Therefore the board of supervisors is hereby respectfully requested to make provision for the payment of that portion thereof adjacent to the court house square. Carried.

Resolved, That the Board of Works and City Engineer be requested to report at the next regular meeting of the council on the petition of the property owners for the grading and paving of Huron Street, as to whether or not a majority of the property owners on said street have petitioned for said grading and paving. Carried.

(Offered by Ald. Coon.)

Resolved, That new sidewalks are a public necessity and the same are hereby ordered built and constructed as follows: Stone or cement along and in front of the property known as the Ford estate on the north side of South University avenue; Also stone or cement walks along and in front of

the property known as the Dr. Gibbs' property on the south side of South University ave. Also, plank walks on the east side of Michigan ave., in front of the following property, between East University avenue and Wells street. Carried.

Whereas, on the 12th day of August, A. D., 1899, the City Treasurer duly certified and returned to the Common Council the list of unpaid taxes which had before then been spread, and levied on the special assessment roll for the extension of East Catherine street in the City of Ann Arbor, Michigan.

Therefore resolved, and the City Assessor is hereby directed and required to carry all and singular all of the said unpaid and delinquent taxes so by the City Treasurer returned, on and into the city tax assessment roll for State, County and School purposes for the year 1899. Together with a penalty of ten per cent on each dollar of the sum total of such delinquent taxes so assessed and returned against each particular description of land in the said certificate mentioned and described.

Resolved further, that the City Clerk do certify this order and directions to the City Assessor pursuant to law.

Ald. Richard's petition for a sidetrack on Miller ave. was referred to Street Committee.

By Ald. Bliton.

Resolved, That a new cross walk be constructed at the crossing of Hill and Olivia avenue; also that \$25 be allowed for the grading and graveling of S. Forest ave., south of Hill st. That \$75.00 be allowed for the graveling of Hill st., from East University ave. to Olivia place. Referred to Street Committee.

On motion the Board of Review adjourned until the 6th day of November at 2 o'clock standard time. Carried.
