December 18th, 1899.

Regular session.

Called to order by Pres. Seabolt.

Roll call. Quorum present.

Absent: Ald. Dieterle, Ronde, Vandawarker, Weeks, Grose—5.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

The communication from the Board regarding the purchase of 30,000 feet of three-inch oak plank was received.

Mr. Coon moved that the Council concur in the Board's report.

As a substitute Mr. Bliton moved that the Board advertise for bids for same.

The report of the city physician that the two free beds had been granted the city, was received, and on motion of Ald. Hamilton the report was received. Carried.

Ald. Bliton moved that the Board of Public Works notify the parties owning walk on the corner of Hill and

Olivia ave., on the south side of Hill st. to the alley, to have same repaired. Carried.

By Ald Brown:

Moved that the petition of Mr. Wethersee be referred to the Finance Committee. Carried.

Ald. Richards moved that the clerk be ordered to draw a warrant in favor of Schneider Bros. for Huron st. storm sewer, due six months from date of acceptance, the amount to be according to the estimate furnished by the engineer.

Adopted as follows:

Nays—None.

On motion of Ald. Brown the clerk was ordered to draw warrants for salaries of all city officers, so same could be used for Christmas time.
