Gentlemen — Your Committee, to whom was referred the matter of locating street car tracks on W. Huron st. and Jackson ave., beg to report as follows:

We have examined the condition and recommend that the center of the track be placed 33 feet south of the north side of Jackson ave. and to follow the center line of W. Huron st. to the bridge to be erected. We also recommend that the Railway Company grade the full width of the street as now laid out and deposit the earth on cross streets between Miller ave. and Liberty st., and that all grading be under the direction of the City Engineer.
