To Ross Granger, City Clerk: You will call a special meeting of the Common Council to take place in the council chamber, city hall, at 7:30 o'clock p. m., Monday, August 12th, 1912, for the purpose of receiving reports from the City Engineer and Board of Public Works on pavements ordered by the council, including recommendations as to width, etc., of Ashley st., and to take such action on the same as is thought best.

(From Board of Public Works.)

By Mr. James: Resolved, that inasmuch as there were no bids received for the construction of pavements ordered on Ashley st. from Huron st. to William st., and on Liberty st., from Ashley st. to the city limits, the Street Commissioner is hereby instructed to grade and pave said streets, under the direction of the City Engineer.

Resolved, further, that the City Clerk notify the Common Council of the Board's action in the matter as provided in Sec. 137 of the city charter. Adopted as follows: Yeas, Messrs. Reule, Koch, Hubbard, James, Scott, Pres. Cornwell, 6. Nays, none.

(Action of Council.)

Moved by Ald. Murray, that report be concurred in.

Moved by Ald. Manwaring, that the motion be amended to provide that distilled tar be used on the pavements.

Amendment lost by following vote: Yeas, Ald. Schmid, Koernke, Manwaring, Schultz, Pipp, Sherk, Lutz, 7. Nays, Ald. Hochrein, Lindenschmitt, Murray, Prochnow, Pres. Mills, 5.

Original motion lost by following vote: Yeas, Ald. Hochrein, Lindenschmitt, Murray, Prochnow, Pipp, Pres. Mills, 6. Nays, Ald. Schmid, Koernke, Manwaring, Schultz, Sherk, Lutz, 6.

(From Board of Public Works.)

Moved by Mr. Scott, that the recommendation of City Engineer Osgood, that Ashley st., between Huron st. and the south line of Walker property, be forty feet in width, and

balance of street south be thirty-four feet in width, be approved by the Board, and so recommended to the Council. Adopted.

(Action of Council.)

Moved by Ald. Lutz, that recommendation of Board of Public Works be referred to the Street committee.

Lost by following vote: Yeas, Ald. Lutz, 1. Nays, Ald. Schmid, Hochrein, Koernke, Manwaring, Lindenschmitt, Schultz, Murray, Prochnow, Pipp, Sherk, Pres. Mills, 11.

Moved by Ald. Manwaring, that the report of the Board of Public Works, relative to paving Ashley and Liberty sts. by the Street Commissioner, under the direction of the City Engineer, be concurred in; provided, that distilled tar be used on Ashley st., and that the material to be used on Liberty st., for the wearing surface, be determined later.

Adopted as follows: Yeas, Ald. Schmid, Hochrein, Koernke, Manwaring, Lindenschmitt, Schultz, Murray, Prochnow, Pipp, Sherk, Lutz, Pres. Mills, 12. Nays, none.

Ald. Lindenschmitt moved that recommendation of the Board of Public Works that Ashley st., between Huron st. and south line of Walker property, be forty feet wide, and balance of street south be thirty-four feet in width, be adopted.

Ald. Manwaring moved to amend by empowering the Engineer to make roadway as near forty feet as possible, to conform to the curbing now in place.

Amendment adopted as follows: Yeas, Ald. Hochrein, Koernke, Manwaring, Lindenschmitt, Schultz, Murray, Prochnow, Pipp, Sherk, Lutz, Pres. Mills, 11. Nays, Ald. Schmid, 1.

Plans and specifications for North Ashley, as presented by the Board of Public Works.

Hon. Board of Public Works, Ann Arbor, Mich.: Gentlemen—I herewith submit plans, specifications and approximate estimate of the cost of paving North Ashley st., from Huron st. to Catherine st., with the Ann Arbor type of Tar-Concrete pavement. The plan shows the pavement forty feet wide from Huron st. to Ann st., and thirty-four feet wide from Ann st. to Catherine st.

1300 cu. yds. excavation at 50c	\$650.00
2585 sq. yds. concrete pavement, with tar and sand wearing surface, at 85c	2197.25
1135 lin. ft. concrete curbing at 22c	249.70
6 inlets to care for storm water at \$8.00	48.00
Legal advertising, engineering, superintendence and tools charged at 10 percent of the above	314.50
Total	\$3459.45
Of this amount the city's portion will be:	
456 sq. yds. pavement at intersections at 85c	\$387.60
250 cu. yds. excavation at intersections at 50c	125.00
125 lin. ft. of curbing at intersections at 22c	27.50
20 percent of the remainder of the above total	583.87
Total	\$1123.97
And the remainder or property owner's portion	\$2335.48
