#### Mayor's Call.

Mr. Ross Granger, City Clerk:— You will call a special meeting of the Common Council at the Council Chamber, Saturday, June 21st, 1913, at ten o'clock p. m., to consider the paving of West Huron street, the rights of the Detroit, Jackson and Chicago Railway company and their duties under the franchise, and to take such action on the same as in Common Council's judgment is best. Moved by Ald. Groves, that the

city attorney get out an injunction against the Detroit, Jackson and Chicago Railway company, prohibiting the said railway company from constructing any spur within the city limits, crossing any lawn extension or any street in the city not covered with a franchise.
